Having members of my family incarcerated, to include my son, gave me the desire and the motivation to work with the LCRC to help with finding ways to aid our Returning Citizens to reenter the social aspects of society without feeling as if no one cares. I continue to see the positive results of LCRC, and I continue to want to help the adults returning from incarceration the opportunity to achieve positive goals which will help cut the recidivism of returning to incarceration.
